1912 – Fall and Rise

The sinking of the "Titanic" in 1912 marks the end of an era as well as the irresistible evolution of modernism. 1912 reveals an amazing plenty of remarkable ongoings: with Jules Massenet the era of the "Grande Opera" dies - whereas the most radical musical rebel of the 20th century, John Cage, is born. The vast spectrum of musical styles and creativity shows best with the world premiers of Arnold Schönberg's Pierrot Lunaire and Richard Strauss' Ariadne auf Naxos.
