isa – International Summer Academy

After 33 years in the Semmering-Rax Region, isa - International Summer Academy of the mdw moves to Vienna in 2025. The newly expanded mdw campus at Anton-von-Webern-Platz offers state-of-the-art facilities, ensuring an ideal and sustainable venue.

Founded in 1991 as a master class for 13 students, isa has grown into a globally unique enrichment program, combining elite training with an interdisciplinary academic conference. Under mdw Vice Rector Johannes Meissl's artistic directorship, it annually welcomes over 200 musicians from 40+ nations.

The move enhances interdisciplinary exchange, strengthens social and intercultural connections, and broadens access to top-tier performances. Additionally, isa aims to leverage its Vienna location for new participatory offerings, collaborating with the city's music mediators and community musicians.

The mdw - University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna, which organises the International Summer Academy, is one of the world's largest and most renowned universities specialised in music, theatre and film. Over 3,000 students from more than 70 countries pursue higher education here in 115 degree programmes.

The mdw's 25 institutes include the Max Reinhardt Seminar and the Vienna Film Academy.

We want to bring people to our Campus and also to go out into the city. Parallel to the artistic isa, the isaResearch Summer School for Early Stage Researchers will discuss current developments in music and society, with presentations of carefully selected papers and high-calibre discussion panels.

Over the past few years, Artistic Research has established its own unique profile at the mdw. Students from the Doctor Artium programme will give isa participants an insight into the wide variety of transdisciplinary artistic research projects at the mdw.

We look forward to having a fantastic time together - and above all, we look forward to meeting you, the participants!

The isaResearch Summer School is dedicated to supporting early stage researchers by providing an interdisciplinary and international forum for theoretical and discursive engagement. It explores the annual isatheme in relation to current issues and embeds it within the diverse contexts of Vienna's urban space.

Taking place alongside the artistic masterclasses and the festival on campus, the Summer School marks a new chapter for isa's research track, fostering exchange between artistic and academic perspectives.

Master class fees include practicing opportunities, participation in workshops, lectures, competitions, and free admission to selected concerts of the isaFestival.

Alongside opportunities to perform Summer Academy repertoire, the festival will also feature outstanding interpretations by participants.
